From the President

Some of our FSMC members have heard, but for those that haven't, Shortly Tompkin's 1914 cyclone was stolen (see page 18 in the Spring, 2012 National Magazine), it was valued at \$520,000. The thieves broke into the owner's house located in Bell Air Calif. They also took a 1961 Honda CR110, 50cc racer. The total value was about \$1,000,000. The owner reported that at 4:30a.m. two men kicked in the front door and went right to the Cyclone. When the owner's confronted the thieves, the thieves tied them up. These bikes did not have insurance on them.

The owner is not the only one to lose on this theft. The motorcycle antiques people will also lose; these bikes will never be in the public eye again and also there was no insurance on these bikes. Walneck's Classic Cycle magazine has a very good article in their April, 2012 issue on the problem. None of our antique motorcycle are safe anymore and with all the finical problems people are having today it even more important to secure our bikes. If you don't have a home or shop security system get one, don't tell people where you keep your bikes and how many you have. If you have a neighbor that you trust tell him when you are leaving for a vacation and put insurance on your bikes. If someone wants to take pictures of your bikes tell them not to put the pictures on a computer with your name. Shorty's Cyclone was published a lot and the high price made it a likely one to steal.

On a happier note, our yearly FSMC dinner turned out very nicely. Richard Ostrander did a great job. Thanks Rich!

We plan on having a club display at the Motorcycle Awareness Day which will be Sunday, May 20 at Sierra College in Rocklin. Also, remember the Ishi Chapter is having their swap meet and show in Chico on May 27, 2012. They have been a help to us at Dixon so let's give them our support!

Minutes of the General Meeting February 4, 2012

The meeting, held at the Hof Brau was called to order promptly at 1:00p.m. by president, Rich Hardmeyer, there were eighteen members in attendance.

Minutes: Jim Moore moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the December 3 meeting. Motion was seconded by Rich Kinney and passed. The minutes will stand as written.

Treasurer's Report: Marie Moore reported that we are beginning the year with 104 paid members and our bank balance continues to remain in a healthy condition.

Old Business: Rich Ostrander reported that he is in the process of purchasing the prizes for our annual dinner on the 18th. So far he has received twenty-six reservations.

Shari Pratt, our web master, has been having trouble writing web codes, she plans to meet with her son-in-law shortly to get some help and instruction. Meanwhile, Dave Kafton and Rich Ostrander suggested Shari contact Bryan Davidson of the Yerba Buena chapter to find out what kind of software their club is using and to arrange with him for some help in setting the program up. Dave Kafton also said that his daughter, D'Nell might be of some help with initial set up and overall organization of the site. A motion was made (Wiebens/Kafton) to authorize the funds (no amount was stipulated) for purchase of website software. Motion passed. Shari will report on her progress at the next meeting.

New Business: It was decided we would apply for permission to hold a national road run in 2013, the tentative date would be September 22 through 25, 2013 if no date around that time is available then we would put off the road run until 2014. No exact location was selected but Rich Ostrander said he has been working on some routes centered around the Sacramento area and reaching into the Jackson and/or Delta region. Jim Moore will submit our application.

Regarding the Dixon meet: Dave Kafton is working on the caterers and will contact the Yerba Buena Chapter to see if they would be willing to cater the "Early Comers" dinner again this year. Rich Ostrander is working on the trophies and Jim Innman has completed the design for the T-shirts however, it looks like the price of T-shirts has gone up quite a bit. Jim is going to shop around and see what kind of prices he can get from other vendors. Dave has been talking with one of the producers at KMAX-TV Channel 31 who is interested in doing a live broadcast from the Dixon meet this year. Mark Wiebens is working on having the sign in front of the fair grounds changed.

Bob Pratt announced that Motorcycle Awareness Day with swap meet will be Sunday, May 20 at Sierra College in Rocklin and plans to have a display of antique bikes again this year. The annual A&S show in Roseville will be held Saturday, September 29. The Ishi Chapter will hold its fourth annual swap meet and show Sunday, May 27.

Dave Kafton said this the Cannonball Run will be September 7 through 23 and will end up, after a police escorted crossing of the Golden Gate Bridge, at Dudly Perkins shop in South San Francisco. The Yerba Buena Chapter has stepped up to help with the organization and expense of the closing ceremonies. Briefly, any person or organization that makes a donation will have their name included on a large sign and be allowed to join in the crossing of the Golden Gate and the following ride to Dudley Perkins shop providing they are riding an AMCA approved vintage motorcycle. Rich Ostrander made a motion, seconded by Rich Kinney, to donate \$1,500.00 (matching Yerba Buena's contribution) towards the cause. Motion passed.

There will be dealers and vendors there plus riding exhibitions and demo rides. There will also be MSF basic, experienced and advanced rider courses.


We will definitely have our Fort Sutter booth set up and will be putting on an informal antique bike show open to AMCA members only with a people's choice trophy to be awarded.
