Yerba Buena National Road Run September 23-25, 2019

The AMCA Yerba Buena Chapter based out of the San Francisco Bay area traveled south to the Monterey Bay area to host their National Road Run.

Close to twenty Fort Sutter Chapter members joined their fellow riders from all over the US and a couple of foreign countries. Canada & England were represented, as well as, Hawaii, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, North Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, New Mexico, Arizona, Nevada, Oregon, Washington, South Dakota, Wisconsin, and more. 145 bikes and riders.

At least 35 Knuckleheads, about 25 panheads, some Shovelheads, a spattering of J models, V models, a Vincent, a few BMW's, Indian Chiefs and Sport Scouts, plus a few British and Japanese models to round out the mix in the parking lot. The Knuckleheads were most impressive with a couple of 1936's, and more than half a dozen of 1937- 38's, a couple '39's and my '40.

As is the case these days there were at least twenty "young guns" and a few gray beards astride vintage long bike choppers.

The worst section was Monday over a potholed goat trail that tired those mounted on ridged framed machines. Tuesday and Wednesday's routes were great! The food that was catered for the banquet, and on the days route lunches were most excellent.

They also had Richie Valen's little (not so little now) brother's Blues Band play for us at the American Legion hall on Tuesday night. The banquet Wednesday night had great food, a raffle, awards handed out and Ricky Najera was awarded "Honorary Member" status by the AMCA's National Secretary, John Markley.


