Treasurer's Report: Julie Loewen provided an update to the financial status and states the Club is in good order.

#### **Old Business:**

- **SacAutoShow:** Mark Loewen thanked everyone who brought their antique motorcycles for display at the 2019 SacAutoShow. At 10:30 a.m. it was time to leave. You could hear the roar as the motorcycles headed west on Elder Creek Rd. towards Hwy 99. The freeway traffic was exceptionally slow due to road construction and accidents.
