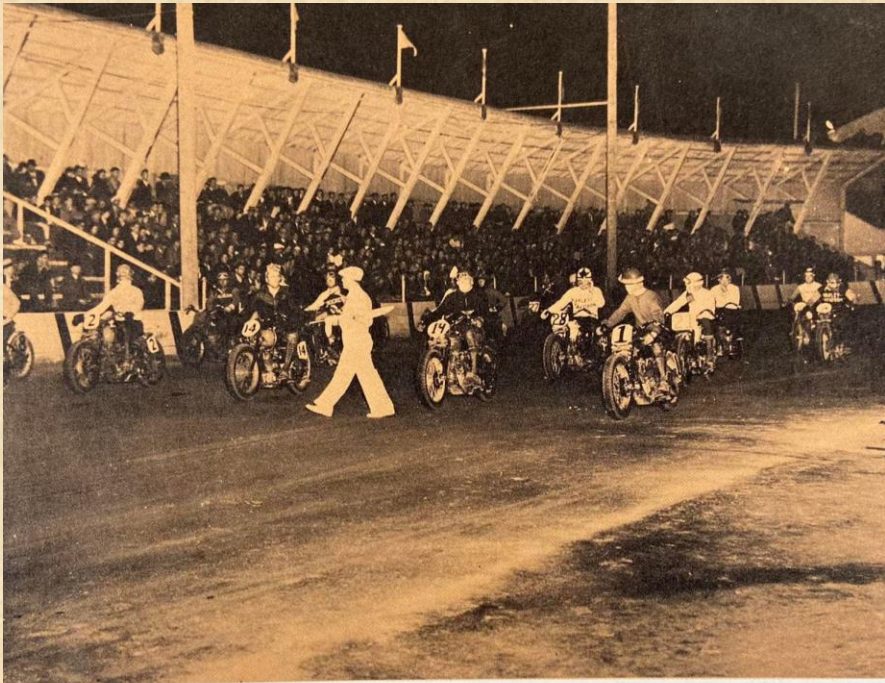
Fort Sutter May 29 Ride to Chico – Ishi Chapter Annual Swap Meet

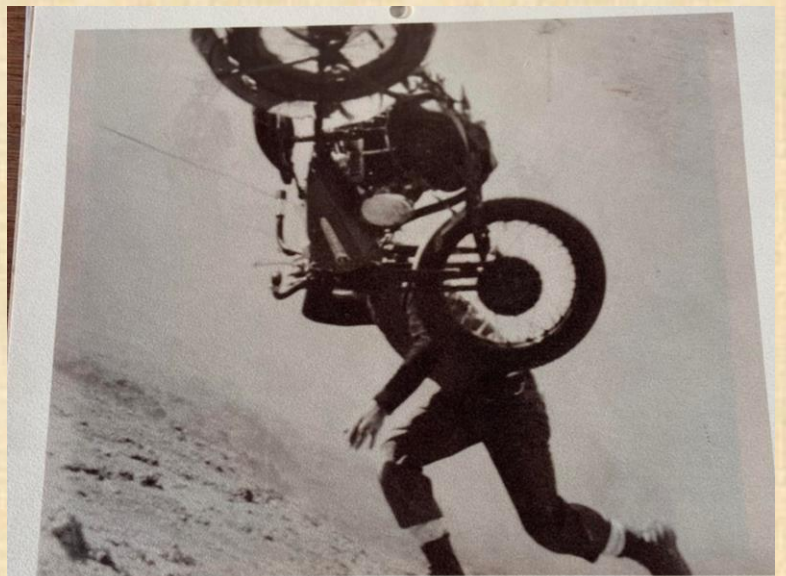

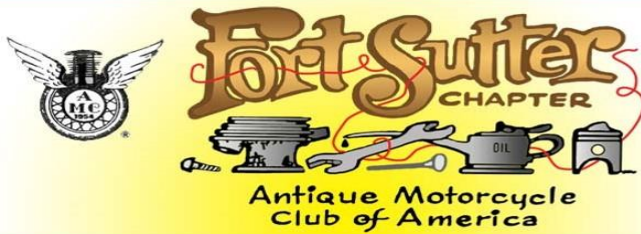

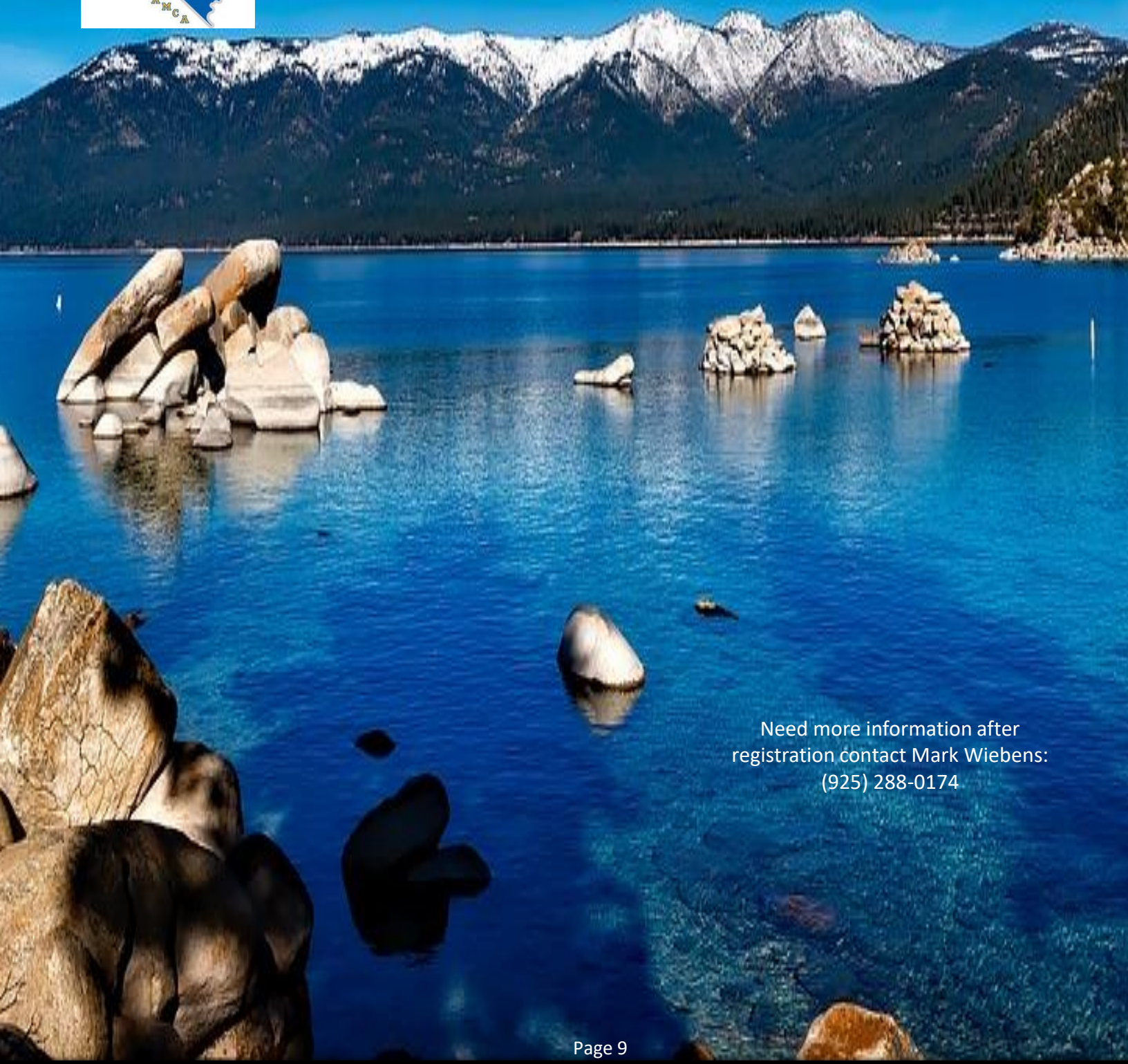


The Fort Sutter invites riders to enjoy California's most beautiful areas with scenic routes, fresh air, friends and old iron rolling through the mountains.
