Fort Sutter Meeting & Annual Picnic & Meeting Minutes October 1, 2022


- Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at: 1:00 pm by Mark Loewen, President. There were 21 members in attendance.
- Welcome New Members: None in attendance
- **Membership**: Karie Schenken will update the current roster at our next meeting. Reminder to all Fort Sutter members renew your Club membership at the December 3, 2022, meeting.
- **Treasury Report**: Julie Loewen reported that the Treasury balance is \$9,892.18 currently. A full accounting of the treasury will be forthcoming.
- **Minutes**: A motion was made by Rich Kinney and seconded by Gary Kubodera to approve the August 13, 2022; minutes as written.

Old Business

- Evergreen Chapter Road Run: Rich Ostrander reported on the Evergreen's Road Run "Ride on the Dry Side" recently held September 19-21, 2022. A Road Run in the scenic Okanogan highlands of Northeastern Washington. Rich said this road run was in the Top 5 of all Road Runs he has participated in. The ride based out of Benny's Colville Inn, located in Colville, WA., a small town in the drier area of the state. The daily rides were fantastic and close to the Canadian border.
- Fort Sutter Road Run update: Mark L. reviewed the recently held Fort Sutter Road Run in South Lake Tahoe. The hotel selected, proved adequate to accommodate all who attended including their trailers. The location was across the street from several restaurants and shops. He thanked all who helped with the Road Run. The banquet was held outside with the temperatures unusually warm for this time of year. The hotel provided a firepit to help keep everyone warm as the nighttime temps grew cooler. Pictures are included in this newsletter.
- **SACAUTOSHOW**: Mark advised everyone that the Sacramento Auto Show will not be held in 2022 due to shortage of micro chips for most new vehicles.

New Business

- Fort Sutter Promotion: A discussion was held regarding attending more events where the Fort Sutter booth would be set up to promote the Fort Sutter Club. Tracy Stahlman suggested bringing the Fort Sutter EZ-up to the NORCAL Cycle SWAP in Sacramento on November 13th and December 11th. John M. offered to help staff the booth. Other volunteers will be needed in the future. Promotional material will be provided at the booth.
- **November/December Rides:** Tracy Stahlman, Road Captain, announced that there Nevada Toy Run will be held on Saturday, December 10, 2022.
- Fort Sutter Board of Directors: Two Fort Sutter Board Members, Mark Loewen and Karie Schenken, 2-year terms will end on 12/31/2022. Nominations are open and voting will take place at the 12/3/2022 meeting. All nominations to be submitted to John Markley, Secretary prior to the December 3, 2022, meeting. Note: all potential nominees must have been asked if they would like to serve on the Fort Sutter Board prior to submitting their name.
- The 2023 Fort Sutter National Motorcycle Show & Swap Meet will take place on June 16-17, 2023. A discussion was held to determine the theme for 2023. Rich Ostrander stated this will be Fort Sutter's 40th year providing a Swap Meet. Why not use this as our 2023 Theme? A discussion was held and agreed that for 2023 the theme will be 40Th Year providing a Swap Meet.
- Meeting adjourned at: 2:25 p.m.














