### Fort Sutter Meeting Minutes August 12, 2023

- Call to Order: The June 3, 2023, meeting was called to order at: 12:05 pm by Bob Henry, Fort Sutter President
- Treasury Report: Julie reported that the treasury is in good order after the Dixon event. Special thanks go out to our donor sponsors of Temple Coffee, Russ Brown Attorneys and KIWI Indian. In addition, thanks go out to our Raffle Prize donors and the gifts they provided.
- Minutes: The minutes from the June 3, 2023, were deferred until the next meeting.

#### **Old Business**

• Fort Sutter National Motorcycle Show & Swap Meet: Bob began the meeting by saying that there were so many people who volunteered their time and effort, and it showed by the fantastic turn out of vendors and the public. He thanked everyone for their efforts!

#### **New Business**

- 2024 Fort Sutter Banquet: Tracy Kleber, Banquet Coordinator, reviewed the upcoming banquet set for February 4, 2024. The possible locations that are available for our large group were discussed. The list included the Cattlemens Restaurant in Rancho Cordova, Piatti's in Sacramento, and the Hook & Ladder also in Sacramento. After reviewing the menu choices and price per person a vote was taken, and the Cattlemens Restaurant in Rancho Cordorva was chosen.
- Fort Sutter Trailer: Bob asked the membership to consider an idea of purchasing a large (20' min.) box trailer, either new or used, to store all the items currently residing in the storage unit in Dixon. The trailer would be stored somewhere near Elk Grove and when needed, it would be retrieved and used to deliver the Fort Sutter E-Z UP tents etc. to local outside marketing events. To help promote the Fort Sutter the trailer it would be wrapped highlighting the Fort Sutter Chapter with logo etc. Vendors would be offered space on the trailer to purchase logo space on the side of the trailer to help offset storage costs and help promote their business.. After discussion, Tracy Stahlman offered to contact several trailer locations for new/used available trailers. In addition, Bob asked the members in attendance at the meeting to contact him if they know of any available trailers. After all information is collected it will be discussed and evaluated to bring this idea back to the membership for consideration.
- 2024 Dixon theme: Bob asked the membership to offer theme suggestions for the upcoming Dixon National Meet in June 2024. After discussion, it was agreed the idea of using the Fab 50's theme would be appropriate since the year 1954 was when the AMCA was founded. By using the Fab 50's theme a combination of early '50's motorcycles could be included on the T-shirt and marketing material. More information to follow.
- Health Update: Karie Schenken provided an update on Dennis Gill's recent foot surgery. A former long-time
  member of Fort Sutter before moving to Arkansas where they now reside. The Gills were very active with the
  Chapter, in fact, Dennis was the Chapter's Deputy Judge. A very large "Get Well" card was circulated for


